HOW TO LOWER THE HIGH COST OF WEEDING.

DON'T PICK WEEDS –

WHEN TO APPLY

- Just before target weeds appear.
- A fall application makes a great treatment because it will stop winter, fall and many spring-germinating weeds.
- One application may control broadleaf weeds year-round in Northern states.
- Two applications may be needed in Southern states.

HOW TO APPLY ALONE

- Use a well-calibrated low-pressure herbicide sprayer. Spray tip screens should be no finer than 50 mesh.
- Make sure spray equipment is clean and not dirty with other herbicides.
- Use clean water.
- Fill tank halfway.

- Start mixing, and continue during filling and application.
- Slowly add the right amount of Gallery* to the tank.
- Mixing should create a rippling or rolling action on the top of the liquid.
- Check often to make sure equipment is spraying evenly.

SPRAY DRIFT

 Avoid spray drift when applying, otherwise nontarget plants near the treated area may not germinate or emerge.



WATERING

- A single rainfall or sprinkler irrigation of 0.5 inch or more, or flood irrigation after application is needed to activate.
- It stays on the surface for up to 21 days.



CLEANING UP

 Clean spray tank, lines and screens thoroughly after use.

WHERE TO APPLY

• In ornamentals and turf.

HOW TO STORE

- In original container, and not in direct sunlight.
- Do not store at temperatures higher than 120 F.
