**PECANS:** Broadcast from the trunk to the dripline. For trees up to 7 inches in diameter, apply 1 3/4 lbs. per inch of diameter. For trees over 7 inches in diameter, apply 3 1/2 lbs. per inch of diameter. Product should be worked into soil to prevent washing away.

CORN: To correct "white bud" of corn caused by Zinc deficiency, apply 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. (20 lb. per acre).

**PEACH & GRAPE:** To correct "little leaf" caused by Zinc deficiency, apply 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. (20 lb. per acre).
