DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR GENERAL USE IN SPRAY MIXTURES:

(in Gallons Per Acre)			
Conc.	Field & Row Crops	Tree & Orchard	Rate of Spreader-Sticker per 100 gl.
Dilute	100-150	500-1000	1 Pint

Use 16 ounces (1 pint) per acre or 100 gallons of spray. Add to the spray tank after other materials have been thoroughly mixed with water. After adding SA-50 Spreader-Sticker, mix thoroughly before spraying.

IN CONCENTRATE SPRAYS:

2X	50-80	300-500	1 - 2 Pints
3X	35-50	200-300	1 Quart
5X	20-32	100-200	2 Quarts
10X	10-16	50-100	1 Gallon
